

H1 2023: consolidated revenue up 12.1% to €553.7m at current exchange rates (+13.4% at constant exchange rates)

The Group reported first-half consolidated revenue from its operating subsidiaries of **€553.7m**, against €494.2m in the same period last year, an increase of 12.1% at current exchange rates. At constant exchange rates, consolidated revenue grew 13.4% to **€560.5m**.

Half-year consolidated revenue by business segment was up 11.1% at current exchange rates or 12.5% at constant exchange rates, for the interdealer broking (IDB) segment, while the online trading segment was up 30.1%.

In the second quarter, consolidated revenue was €263.4m, compared with €240.9m in 2022, an increase of 9.3% at current exchange rates. At constant exchange rates, revenue was up by 12.4%.

There has been no significant change in the Group's financial situation since the publication of its 2022 financial statements.

*The variations in income statement items at current exchange rates are calculated based on average rates for the period compared with average rates for the previous period when translating the currencies of the Group's consolidated subsidiaries. The variations in income statement items at constant exchange rates are calculated using the average exchange rates for the period N-1 over both comparison periods.
